CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY BY FOREIGN ADMINISTRATIONS [Circular NMC1.2025 (rev1)]

(A) PURPOSE:

To provide the list of Foreign Maritime Administrations whose COC are accepted for issuance of Niue COE in accordance with STCW I/10.

(B) DEFINITIONS:

The following abbreviations stand for:

1. "COC" – Certificate of Competency issued under STCW
2. "COE" – Certificate of Endorsement issued under STCW I/10
3. "STCW" – International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended
4. "OOW" – Officer in charge of a Navigation Watch
5. "OEI" – Officer in charge of an Engineering Watch

The term "Administration" shall mean the Niue Ship Registry.

(C) APPLICATION:

This circular applies to all ship officers serving on Niue-flagged ships.

RECOGNITION OF COCs BY FOREIGN MARTIME ADMINISTRATIONS NOT LISTED UNDER NIUE MARINE CIRCULAR NMC2025.1

1. In addition to the documents specified in Section C 4.7 of Niue Registry Circular NRC6.2012, applications for Niue Crew Endorsements for officers who hold STCW CoCs not listed under Niue Marine Circular NMC2025.1 will be required to submit sea service record according to the table below.
2. Notwithstanding the above, the Niue Administration reserves the right to not recognize STCW CoCs that are not listed under Niue Marine Circular NMC2025.1.
